What is the Knowledge Self-Assessment?

Before July 2016, Family Physicians were required to complete a Self-Assessment Module (SAM) that included both a 60-question knowledge assessment plus a clinical simulation. Now, the Knowledge Self-Assessment (KSA) is the minimum required self-assessment activity. Complete the KSA on Thursday with other colleagues, and earn 10 certification points and 8 CME credits toward diplomates' certification requirements. The Clinical Self-Assessment is still available as an optional self-assessment activity that can be completed on your own for 5 certification points and 4 CME credits toward certification requirements. This no longer is a requirement to earn immediate credits for a completed KSA. The content of the KSA on Medical Genomics effectively merges clinical practice and current evidencebased medical research.

Additional registration and cost-\$150 is required (see registration form), and will be limited to the first 20 registrants. The session will be held Thursday, 1:00-5:30 pm.
