Registering to Become a Certified Medical Examiner and Finding a Testing Organization Cheat Sheet

Before you can sign-up to take the medical examiner test you must complete a certified training course <u>and</u> register with the DOT National Registry. To find a training course offered by the Nebraska Academy of Family Physicians visit <u>www.nebrafp.org</u>.

You must take a valid form of ID, a copy of your medical license, and the training certificate to the testing center.

Register to Become a Certified Medical Examiner

- 1. Go to the U.S. Department of Transportation National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners website: <u>https://nationalregistry.fmcsa.dot.gov</u>.
- 2. Click on "Register to Become Certified" in the Medical Examiners box on the right side of the screen. Click "start today."



Find a Testing Organization

- 1. Go to the U.S. Department of Transportation National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners website: <u>https://nationalregistry.fmcsa.dot.gov</u>.
- 2. Click on "Find a Testing Organization" in the Medical Examiners box on the right side of the screen. I recommend putting in your zip code and changing the radius to 500 miles.



3. A list of all testing organizations will be displayed. You will have to call the testing center and set up a testing time. Each testing center may have different testing times and fees. You must take a copy of your medical license and the training certificate to the testing center.
